Extra free kerbside collections for flood-affected residents:

- Central Coast Council has allocated eight extra free bulk waste collections for properties impacted by recent flooding.
- These have been automatically added to eligible properties in the 1Coast booking system and are available until 1 February 2026.
- If you've been affected but don't see the extra entitlements, contact 1Coast or Central Coast Council for assessment.

Please note:

- Flood waste must still be booked in as per the standard bulk waste collection services – Where possible, flood waste will be prioritised, but residents may have to wait until the next collection date.
- Waste materials and types must be in accordance with standard bulk waste terms and conditions (available at 1Coast.com.au and provided at booking).
- Waste must not be placed out for collection until the day before a confirmed booking.
- Hazardous waste such as asbestos, pesticides, gas bottles, or other items not allowed within the standard bulk waste collection service must not be placed out for collection as these items will not be collected and pose a serious threat to both people and the environment – any items not allowed to be placed out for collection must be taken to Councils Waste Facilities or collected by a private waste collection specialist.

This initiative is part of Council's ongoing commitment to supporting the community in its recovery from severe weather events.
